



Theater Skills Workshop 2022

WHO: Boys and girls who are in grades 5-9th and reside in the Towns of Milton, Malta, or Ballston, or the Village of Ballston Spa.

WHEN: Wednesdays from 6pm-8pm

WHERE: Malta Ave Elementary Auditorium

DATES: 1/12, 1/19, 1/26, 2/2 & 2/9

COST: \$30.00 per student per 5-week session (not per class).

This is the cost for residents of the Towns of Milton, Malta, or Ballston, and the Village of Ballston Spa who also reside in the Ballston Spa School District. If you do not reside in the Ballston Spa school district or one of the four listed municipalities, there is an added fee of \$25.00.

ABOUT THE PROGRAM: *Theater Skills is a part of the BARC Arts Program, which is a year-round arts program that explores various aspects of the arts in 5-week segments. This program will be exploring visual art, dance, music & theater. Sessions will be offered to a variety of age groups and locations depending on the modality being explored.*

In this five-week acting intensive, we will be working on basic stage acting skills including, improvisation, scene study and monologues. This is a great class for anyone, grades 5-9, who is interested in acting whether they are novice or experienced. The goal is to create a safe environment where each student can feel free to express themselves through performing.

Shane Sczepankowski has been working in a theatrical capacity for most of his adult life. His educational background is based around collaborative theater making with a strong focus on devising physical work via Shakespeare's texts. As an actor and director, he uses the potential in every rehearsal room to create a safe space to be unique. Most recently Shane's graduate work involves creating a touring troupe of Shakespearean scholars, wherein they traveled around the local community, performing early modern text, and teaching a series of educational workshops that he developed as a co-op company.
